Three years ago, I set off on a protracted journey to help raise the awareness of the Virginia shap



Virginia shag clubs within the ACSC (Association of Carolina Shag Clubs) community. I say protracted because the vetting process was more detailed than any paying job I ever applied for. I had to submit samples of my work, provide links to photos I had posted on line, provide references from all my clubs, and I had two interviews. Luckily, I was accepted.
