

and months seem to accelerate each year.




- Decisions that we make at this meeting should be in the best interest of all our members and not our own personal agendas.

The following is paraphrased from various shag club websites

Shag Etiquette

- 1. It is equally permissible for a woman to ask a man to dance as it is for a man to ask a woman.
- 2. If you don't want to dance, say "No thank you." Don't dance with someone if you just turned down a request to dance. If someone says "no thanks." do not be persistent — take them at their word.
- 3. It is not polite to correct your partner on the dance floor.
- 4. It is not polite to offer instruction to someone in a social dance setting (or in a dance class if you are not the instructor). Unless they ask for help or are hurting you, don't teach. If your partner requests help, kindly take them off to the side away from the other social dancers.
- 5. Be aware of the dancers around you. It's a fairly accepted practice that, when a collision occurs, apologize, even if it wasn't your fault.
- 6. Find your spot and keep your slot. The first person on the floor usually has the right to set the slot of the dance. Dance Small! If you require half of the floor in order to do your thing, you need to change your thing.
- 7. Step off the dance floor if you're not dancing. If you are drinking a beverage, stay off the dance floor.
- 8. Leaders, when dancing with a less experienced partner, keep the steps simple at first and build to the level that your partner can handle. Leading should be defined as "the art of making your partner comfortable."
- 9. Leaders, protect your partner. Because you are directing her movement, you need to be sure to protect her safety.
- 10. Leaders, if you must count and give verbal leads, keep it low enough that just you and your partner can hear. It can confuse those around you.

Janis Grimes has been selected for induction into the Beach **Shaggers National Hall of** Fame. The induction ceremony will be held on October 12th in North Myrtle Beach.

The Beach Shaggers National Hall of Fame is the original Hall of Fame for shag dancers and is generally considered the most prestigious organization honoring shag dancers who deserve special recognition.



For Janis, this is the crowning achievement of thirty-two years of studying the art of dance, competing, promoting and teaching in the Carolina Shag dance world.
